



The Louisiana Public Service Commission (LPSC) recently voted to adopt comprehensive energy efficiency rules. Please note that any account receiving electric power at 69 kilovolts or higher, or any industrial customer account that elected to opt-out during the Commission's Quick Start program, will be automatically excluded, and you are not required to take further action.

The Commission Order does provide other eligible industrial customers a limited opportunity **(closes on October 1, 2025)** to opt-out of the energy efficiency program and billings. Under the Order, eligibility for opt-out is limited to large industrial customers having one or more individual electric service accounts within its utility service providers' service territory with a combined aggregate demand of five thousand (5,000) kW or more. Additionally, the Order provides that only customers with annual peak loads equal to or greater than two hundred (200) kW, located within the utility's service territory, may aggregate. In accordance with the industrial opt-out provisions in the Louisiana Energy Efficiency Programs (LPSC Docket R-31106), we have attached a copy of an opt-out/opt-in form for your consideration. If you have an eligible account(s) that you want to opt-out of or opt-in to the SWEPCO energy efficiency program, please complete the attached form and return it to [SWEPCOEE@aep.com](mailto:SWEPCOEE@aep.com) by **October 1, 2025**. Consistent with the Quick Start energy efficiency program, please note that incomplete or handwritten forms will be returned. Please list each account you wish to opt-out of or opt-in to on a separate line. If you need to list more than nine accounts, please complete a separate form.
